# VISITOR GUIDE

#### **Clubhouse:**

The Clubhouse will open at 7:30am until 9:00pm. Last orders at 8:15pm. Please note that Sunningdale Golf Club is a cashless environment.

### **Etiquette / Social Media:**

Sunningdale respectfully reminds Guests that the Club is a Private Members Club and as such we expect Visitors to adhere to high standards of etiquette and behaviour when on the premises, both on the course and in the Clubhouse.

There is a strict Social Media policy to maintain the private nature of Sunningdale, and we request that Visitors/Members' refrain from taking photographs of any individuals whilst at the Club, to protect all rights for privacy and comfort. Our Visitors and Groups are welcome to arrange photos of their Guests/Groups on the course, but this is strictly prohibited in the Clubhouse.

We request that social media linked to the Club is kept to a minimum. Any posts seen to be inappropriate, will be requested to be removed and may affect rebooking the Club's courses in future.

#### **Dress Code:**

Appropriate dress code is required on the Golf Course and the Clubhouse

- No jeans, collarless shirts or tee-shirts.
- No trainers. Appropriate golf shoes must be worn with either metal spikes or rubber studs.
- Tailored shorts may be worn on the courses and in the bar area. Shorts are not permitted in the Dining Room.
- Jackets & Smart Dress required for Dining Room Lunch & Dinners.
- Golf Attire permitted for Golf Day / Society Breakfasts.

#### **Mobile Telephones:**

These may be used in your car and the Visitors' Locker Room only. Please do not use them on the golf course, in the bars, lounges and dining rooms or on the paths and verandas that surround the Clubhouse.

## **Arrival / Departure:**

On arrival guests should check in for their golf day at their designated registration room. The noticeboard at reception will indicate which room your group will be based for the day.

Entrance gates will open automatically on arrival from 7:30am.

Exit gates require a code supplied to the Organiser for the day. This code is changed daily, please collect this in advance or check on the daily information board upon arrival.

## **Changing Room:**

The Visitor Changing Rooms are on the first floor. Ladies at the top of the stairs and Gentlemen through the double doors and to the right.

#### **Golf Course:**

- Practice Facilities: The practice ground (irons only), short-game area, and putting green are available to all Visitors.
- Tees: All guests must play from the Yellow tees. Ladies will play from the Red tees.
- Pace of Play: The maximum time allocated for the round is as follows:
  2 balls: 3 hours 30 minutes, 3 balls: 3 hours 45 minutes, 4 balls: 4
- hours.Handicaps: Both Old and New are Championship courses that have hosted international tournaments of the highest level. They are not
- Sunningdale recommends that guest's handicaps do not exceed:
- 18 for Gentlemen and 24 for Ladies.

- Golfers are warned, before you play any type of shot; check that any
  other Golfers, members of Staff or members of the public are out of
  range. Greenkeepers regularly work on the courses during the day and
  there are public roads, rights of way and bridle paths crossing the
  courses.
- Halfway House: Located close to the 10th greens of the two courses where refreshments are available. The recommended stop at the hut is 5 minutes.
